4. UK-wide medical cannabis access on NHS pathways for chronic pain and epilepsy.
5. Mandatory accessible transport protocols in heatwaves — medical priority rebooking.
6. Police leadership overhaul with survivor liaison embedded in every force.
7. Transparency audits on political and campaign funds — publish findings publicly.
8. Maternity and NHS inquiry witnesses compelled to testify — end institutional silence.
9. Ethical AI standards co-designed with disabled users before public deployment.
10. ICC membership defended; external arms to abusive forces ended and sanctioned.
